### **BACHELOR OF SCIENCE PROGRAM**

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Professional Studies is offered to all police officers, deputy sheriffs, public-safety training officers, firefighters, disaster planners, emergency medical personnel, highway patrol officers, dispatchers, and other public-safety personnel. The program relies heavily on work experience, thus students need a minimum of 5-7 years experience in their field, as well as time training or teaching their occupation to others. Students may fulfill any lower-division general-education deficiencies while completing the program or after finishing the required CSULB classes. The program emphasizes attitude awareness in the workplace, management operations and techniques, and identifying management competencies.

### **MASTER OF SCIENCE PROGRAM**

The Master of Science in Emergency Services Administration is an accelerated two-year program, designed specifically for emergency-services personnel, deputy sheriffs, police officers, fire personnel, dispatchers, or other public-safety officers. The course emphasizes emergency planning and management, administrative leadership, and critical analysis of issues.

To attend this program, potential students must possess a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution, or be currently enrolled as senior in an accredited undergraduate program, and meet California State University admission requirements (2.5 GPA in last 60 units).
