College of the Canyons (COC) is offering Sheriff's Department personnel the opportunity to earn an Associate of Arts Degree in Criminal Justice. Courses will be held at custody facilities using an intensified 8-week format tailored specifically to the needs of working adults. A number of courses will also be available on-line.

ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

60 total units are needed to complete the requirements for an Associates Degree.

24 units in Administration of Justice core classes

15 units in elective courses

21 units of GE courses, including math, English, humanities, and social sciences

ASSESSMENT AND TESTING

All students must fulfill the math and English requirements to complete their AA degree and/or transfer to a university. Prior to taking math and English, all students need to complete the College Assessment Test. Assessment testing is held once a month at the Sheriff's Department STARS Center. Please contact a member of the LASD University Staff for details.

WORK EXPERIENCE CREDITS

If students meet the prerequisites, COC may award college units toward the completion of an AA degree based on equivalent work experience. For example, credits may be awarded for the Basic Academy, Patrol School, and Jail Operations. Credit may also be awarded for in-service courses.

COSTS

Tuition is \$26 per unit for most courses. Books for each course are additional. Reimbursement is available through LASD University.
