SHERIFF'S INVESTIGATORS ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE DEPUTY INVOLVED SHOOTING IN THE 15500 BLOCK OF HARVEST AVENUE, NORWALK THAT OCCURRED ON DECEMBER 16, 2007, AT APPROXIMATELY 6:18 AM.

DEPUTIES FROM NORWALK STATION WERE RESPONDING TO A CALL OF NUMEROUS SHOTS FIRED WHEN THEY SAW THE SUSPECT DRIVING AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED FROM THE AREA. ONE DEPUTY ATTEMPTED TO STOP THE SUSPECT BUT LOST SIGHT OF THE VEHICLE THEN RELOCATED IT PARKED IN THE 15500 BLOCK OF HARVEST AVENUE, NORWALK.

AS THE DEPUTY DROVE TOWARD THE VEHICLE, THE SUSPECT STEPPED OUT AND POINTED A SEMI-AUTOMATIC HANDGUN AT HIM THEN BEGAN RUNNING TOWARD A BLOCK WALL. THE SUSPECT STOPPED AND AGAIN POINTED THE PISTOL AT THE DEPUTY. FEARING FOR HIS SAFETY, THE DEPUTY FIRED NINE ROUNDS FROM HIS DUTY WEAPON, MISSING THE SUSPECT.
