NARRATIVE: ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 29, 2007, SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES RESPONDED TO MILE MARKER 2.23 ON MOUNT WILSON ROAD, ANGELES NATIONAL FOREST, TO INVESTIGATE THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE DISCOVERY OF APPARENT HUMAN REMAINS. A MAN AND HIS SON WERE HIKING IN THE AREA WHEN THEY SAW WHAT APPEARED TO BE A HUMAN SKULL. THEY NOTIFIED DEPUTIES FROM THE CRESCENTA VALLEY SHERIFF'S STATION, WHO RESPONDED TO THE SCENE.

THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY OFFICE OF THE CORONER RESPONDED AND COLLECTED THE REMAINS FOR FURTHER EXAMINATION. TODAY, (SUNDAY) DECEMBER 30, 2007, THE CORONER'S OFFICE POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED THE REMAINS AS HUMAN; HOWEVER THE IDENTITY AND CAUSE OF DEATH IS STILL UNDER INVESTIGATION.
