SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE IMMINENT DEATH OF AN 18 MONTH OLD INFANT.

ON MAY 4, 2008, AT APPROXIMATELY 1225 PM, LENNOX STATION DEPUTIES RESPONDED TO A "BABY NOT BREATHING " CALL AT THE 14000 BLOCK OF CHADRON AVENUE. WHEN THEY ARRIVED, AN 18 MONTH OLD MALE WAS IN RESPIRATORY DISTRESS. THE CHILD'S CARE GIVER TOLD DEPUTIES AND FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL THE CHILD WAS CHOKING ON A PENNY.

THE CHILD WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL AND IS LISTED IN CRITICAL CONDITION AND IS DEATH IMMINENT.

SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES RESPONDED TO THE HOSPITAL AND THE TODDLER'S HOME AND ARE ENGAGED IN AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE CHILD'S INJURIES.
