The STAR Program provides education to school age children on Santa Catalina Island on the dangers of substance abuse. SCUBA divers and snorklers search for gold stars in depths between ten and fifty feet in the Casino Dive Park in the city of Avalon. The gold stars are searched for in a scenic area of rock and kelp formations and wrecks during an hour and a half period. Divers who find and return a gold star win a prize and a one pound chocolate star. Raffles are held for diver and non-diver prizes.
